REMARKS:

The horn is written in F.

- Accidentals only concern the note before which they are placed, except repeated notes.

Im Windesweben II can alternate its different pieces with the movements of *Im Windesweben III* in this way:

1. **Impromptu I** (first piece of *Im Windesweben II*, for solo French horn)
2. **In the murmuring wind** (first movement of *Im Windesweben III*, for wind quartet)
3. **Nur Träumerei** (second movement of *Im Windesweben II*, for solo French horn)
4. **War meine frage** (second movement of *Im Windesweben III*, for wind quartet)
5. **Impromptu II/a** (first page of the third movement of *Im Windesweben II*, for solo French horn)
6. **Impromptu III** (third movement of *Im Windesweben III*, for wind quartet)
7. **Impromptu/IIb** (second page of the third movement of *Im Windesweben II*, for solo French horn)

This order of alternation can be permuted only in this way:

1. **Impromptu I** (first piece of *Im Windesweben II*, for solo French horn)
2. **Impromptu III** (third movement of *Im Windesweben III*, for wind quartet)
3. **Nur Träumerei** (second movement of *Im Windesweben II*, for solo French horn)
4. **War meine frage** (second movement of *Im Windesweben III*, for wind quartet)
5. **Impromptu II** (third movement of *Im Windesweben II*, for solo French horn)
6. **In the murmuring wind** (first movement of *Im Windesweben III*, for wind quartet)

The performance of the entire cycle can be completed with ***Im Windesweben IV***, for wind quintet.
